



# **SCHOOL IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS**

## **ATTENTION 5TH GRADE PARENTS:**

Get a jump-start on preparing your child for 6th grade by getting his/her immunizations up-to-date!

We are sharing this information with you today, so that you have plenty of time to schedule an appointment to update your child's immunizations with his/her medical provider before the start of the new school year.

The Wisconsin State Department of Health requires the Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis) booster, after 10 years of age for all students entering the 6<sup>th</sup> grade.

### What is Tdap?

Tdap is a vaccine that protects against Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis (whooping cough).

## Why is Tdap Required?

Pertussis is a serious disease. It is easily passed from person to person and cause outbreaks in schools. Wisconsin has experienced two state-wide outbreaks in the last 10 years. People who are ill with pertussis must stay home from work or school for at least five days. Rock county consistently has less than 75% of adolescents immunized for Tdap making it even more important to get immunized. Heard immunity should not be relied upon.
