<u>Tornado In A Bottle</u>

What you'll need:

- Water
- A clear plastic bottle with a cap (that won't leak)
- Glitter (This is optional)
- Dish washing liquid

Instructions:

- 1. Fill the plastic bottle with water until it reaches around three quarters full.
- 2. Add a few drops of dish washing liquid.
- Sprinkle in a few pinches of glitter (this will make your tornado easier to see).(Optional)
- 4. Put the cap on tightly.
- 5. Turn the bottle upside down and hold it by the neck.
- Quickly spin the bottle in a circular motion for a few seconds, stop and look inside to see if you can see a mini tornado forming in the water. You might need to try it a few times before you get it working properly.

What's happening?

Spinning the bottle in a circular motion creates a water vortex that looks like a mini tornado. The water is rapidly spinning around the center of the vortex. Go to <u>BrainPop</u> and learn about equivalent fractions. Write down at least 5 equivalent fractions. Here is an example for you--
