Goal - I can use the art element SHAPE in my art work. Click on the Shapes below. They are a link to a video about how artists use SHAPES in their artwork.






Day 2: Use shapes in

Ask an adult to go on a walk with you this week. When you go on the walk look at the nature around you. What is nature?


Nature is the plants, trees, and animals that live outside. We are going to be drawing these things later in our art project so make sure you pay attention to the nature around you.


