

By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, the percentage of students reading at or above grade level proficiency will be 61% as demonstrated by performance on IRLA. This would be a 25% increase from the previous year. In addition, Gaston will increase the number of students in the advanced/exceeding grade level expectations from 9.1% to 15% as shown by the IRLA from Spring 2024-Spring 2025.

## Math SMARTE Priority Goal

By the end of the spring assessment window, 70% of students in kindergarten through second grades will achieve a score of 70% or higher as measured by the SDB district benchmark. Additionally, 55% of students in third through fifth grade will score at or above the 41st percentile on the spring administration of the math MAP assessment. Specifically, move the number of advanced students (3,4,5) from 3% to 5% as measured by MAPs

## **SEB SMARTE Priority Goal**

During the 2024-2025 school, increase each cohort's spring 2024 climate data for sense of belonging with peers by 10% as compared to Spring 2025 data for the same group of students. Spring 2024: K cohort- 44% 1st cohort -60%, 2nd cohort -55%, 3rd cohort-49%, 4th cohort-36%.
