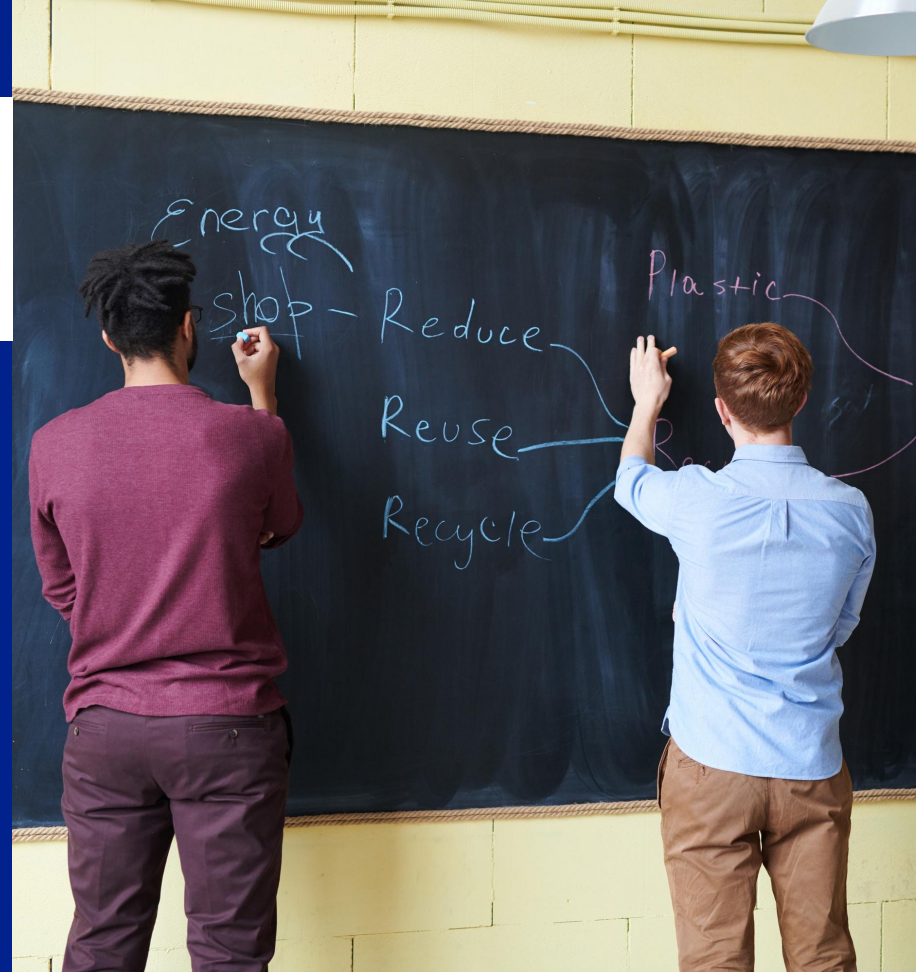


## SCHOOL-WIDE FOCUS
