School District of Beloit Expands Grab and Go Meals To Include Weekends and Delivery

Beloit, Wisconsin, September 21, 2020 – Beginning on Monday, September 28th the School District of Beloit will provide Grab and Go Meals on Monday and Thursdays and are initiating a delivery option.

On Mondays, Grab and Go Breakfast and Lunch Meals will be provided for Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday and on Thursdays Grab and Go Breakfast and Lunch Meals will be provided for Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.

"We wanted to make it easier for families to get their Grab and Go Meals. With this set-up, families only have to visit our sites twice a week," shared Jo Ann Armstrong, Executive Director of Business, HR & Operations. "Healthy nutritious meals for all children in our community is our priority."

With weekends included in the Grab and Go Meal distribution, the District has also made available delivery of meals for those families that are unable to get to our school sites to pick-up meals. "We continue to explore and work to break down barriers for access to food during this time, one way to do that is with a delivery service," said Armstrong. Grab and Go Breakfast and Lunch Meals are available to all children ages one to 18 from 11 am to 1 pm at all elementary schools and Beloit Memorial High School (at the Elizabeth Reinholz Theater) on Monday and Thursdays beginning September 28th.

During the week of September 21 Grab and Go Meals will be distributed daily through Friday, September 25 from 11 am to 1 pm.
