

The School District of Beloit is partnered with Beloit Health System to provide comprehensive medical care and mental health services to students enrolled at Beloit Memorial High School. The following types of services are offered through the Student Health and Wellness Center (SHWC):

- School Physicals / Sports Physicals
- Well child visits and immunizations
- Diagnosis and treatment of acute and chronic disease
- Assessment and treatment of minor injuries
- Basic laboratory testing
- Health education, counseling, and wellness promotion
- Nutrition education and weight management
- Prescription medication
- Mental health services (screening, assessment and treatment)
- Age-appropriate healthcare for the reproductive system; STI testing and treatment, pregnancy testing, abstinence counseling, education, exams, and referrals.
- No contraceptives will be dispensed or prescribed at the SBHC.

A parent/guardian may choose to decline services offered at the SBHC.
