Meal Distribution During Distance Learning: To Begin on Tuesday, September 8th

The district will resume food service under the National School Lunch (NSL) and National School Breakfast (NSB) programs on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>September 8th</u>. Students enrolled in the traditional School District of Beloit model, regardless of in-person or distance learning, are eligible for a breakfast and lunch meal.

Meal distribution will continue at all six elementary locations and at the high school between the hours of 11 AM and 1 PM. <u>Individuals must supply the student's name and the name of their SDB school location to receive a meal under the NSL and NSB program</u>. The meal hotline (361-3136) is still available for students unable to pick up meals from a distribution site.
