


School District of Beloit Family Decision Making Options



Instructional Model:

Beloit Virtual School (BVS)

- •100% Online (K-12 content and instruction provided by K12, Inc)
- •Support and oversight by School District of Beloit staff and teachers
- Parents/Guardians may move their child(ren) between BVS and SDB Traditional Learning at Quarter/Semester

In-Person Instruction

- •When it is safe to return to school
- Face Coverings will be required by Students, Staff, and Visitors
- Best practices of Social Distancing will be followed
- Model of In-Person instruction will be adjusted to accommodate student enrollment and Rock County Health Department guidance
- •Incorporate Common Learning Platform (Seesaw K-3 and Google Classroom 4-12)

Distance Learning

- •Will be the mode of instruction when In-Person Instruction is not possible
- •Common Learning Platform (Seesaw K-3 and Google Classroom 4-12)
- School schedules will incorporate face-to-face time, instruction/checkin with teachers, independent work, and work offline
- Teacher support and availability will be communicated to families

Criteria for Start of School Year:

Transportation

•Ensure that students can arrive to school in a reasonable amount of time

School Capacity

- •Know how many children will be choosing SDB Traditional Learning (In-Person / Distance Learning)
- •Create and adjust Instructional Plan to meet the needs of the number of students attending

- •Rock County is not in Phase 1
- •Rock County 14-day average percentage of positive test is less than 5.00%
- •The Rock County 14-day average percentage of positive test trendline is decreasing
- •September 8th In-Person vs Distance Learning determination will be made on August 14th
