Good Morning School District of Beloit Families,

At last night's Board of Education Special Meeting, I presented a proposal for the return to in-person learning with a cohort model.

In unanimous support, the Board of Education voted to return to in-person learning through a cohort model starting on Thursday, April 8.

Next Steps:

You have the choice to have your child(ren) in distance learning or cohort in-person learning.

By Wednesday morning, you will receive an email through Skyward asking you to decide between distance learning or cohort in-person learning for your child(ren). You may select a different option for each of your children.

You will have until Wednesday, March 10, to decide which learning model is best for your child/teen by accessing your Skyward account.

To help with your decision-making process, I have attached a Family Guide that outlines in detail the cohort in-person model and expectations, as well as a distance learning overview.
