Intermediate School Update:

Our four intermediate schools have worked together to change their Term 2 Distance Learning schedules after reviewing our family survey data. Your feedback was instrumental in creating these positive changes. High School Athletics Update:

Earlier this week, our Athletic Director Joel Beard shared an update on winter sports with our student-athletes and their families. We will leave open the possibility of an earlier return to winter sports and will begin the season with virtual coaching.
