Good Morning School District of Beloit Families,

I have some important information I would like to share with you this morning regarding our Grab and Go Meals; iPad help and outreach; and an upcoming virtual tutorial on Seesaw.

Grab and Go Meals:

Beginning on Monday, September 28th we will be providing Grab and Go Meals on Mondays and Thursdays. On Mondays you will receive a breakfast and lunch meal for Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday and on Thursdays you will receive a breakfast and lunch meal for Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. With this distribution you only have to pick-up meals twice a week. Additionally, if you are unable to pick up meals, we are providing delivery service. Please call (608) 361-3136 to arrange for delivery.

Grab and Go Meals are available from 11 am to 1 pm at all our elementary schools and at Beloit Memorial High School at the Elizabeth Reinholz Theater. All children from ages one to 18 are eligible to receive these meals. During this week Grab and Go Meals are available every day.

iPad Help and Outreach:

The School District of Beloit is partnering with the Beloit Public Library to offer students and families some assistance with navigating iPads. **On Tuesday, September 22nd and Thursday, September 24th from 11 am to 7 pm** the School District of Beloit will have a station set up in the Library to answer questions and help families learn to use apps on the iPad. We will have School District of Beloit Spanish translators available at both sessions. We encourage our families and students to stop by for help and information. No appointment is necessary.

Seesaw Training and Tutorial:

The School District of Beloit is hosting a virtual Parent Academy Session on Wednesday, **September 23, beginning at 5:30 pm.** The focus of this informational session is to share an overview, information, and tips when using Seesaw. Seesaw is being used to deliver curriculum at all our elementary schools during Distance Learning. This session is scheduled to last approximately 30 minutes. Contact your child's elementary school office to sign up and to receive the google meet link. If you are unable to attend, we do plan to post this video under our Parent University Tab on our website later in the week.
