I have lots of important information to share with you this week, including a calendar update for the week of Thanksgiving.

Important Calendar Update:

Monday, November 23 and Tuesday, November 24: Teacher Work Days and Student Assignment Work Days

Our teaching staff will not be providing live instruction during these two days. We encourage all students to spend time getting caught up on assignments and homework during these two days. Our teachers will be working on curriculum and lesson planning during this time.

Wednesday, November 25 through Friday, November 27:

Thanksgiving Break, and no school.

Grab and Go Meals:

On Monday, November 16, we will provide six days of breakfast and lunch meals at all our elementary schools. All children aged one through 18 are eligible for these meals. With six days of meals provided on Monday, we will not have Grab and Go Meals available on Thursday of this week.
