



Request for Proposals School District of Beloit

Communication Consultant for Referendum Planning

Introduction

The School District of Beloit (SDB) is seeking proposals from qualified communications firms or consultants to provide professional services in support of a potential referendum scheduled for April 2026 or November 2026 for three (3) possible scenarios:

- 1) An operational referendum only
- 2) A capital referendum only
- 3) An operational and capital referendum

The selected partner will assist in developing and implementing a comprehensive, transparent, and informative communications plan that engages our community and ensures all stakeholders are well-informed.

2. Background

The School District of Beloit serves a diverse student population and is committed to providing a high-quality education for all students. Facing potential funding needs related to both operational sustainability and capital improvements, the district is considering placing a referendum on the April 2026 election ballot. To ensure transparency and community engagement, the District seeks professional support to communicate referendum-related information to its stakeholders effectively.

3. Scope of Services

The selected firm will provide services including, but not limited to:

A. Strategic Planning

- Develop a communications strategy tailored to the Beloit community
- Provide a timeline and milestone schedule from project launch to election day
- Provide methods of audience sentiment through surveys and other means to develop campaign strategies





B. Messaging and Materials

- Create clear, consistent, and fact-based messaging for all audiences
- Design and produce print and digital materials (brochures, fact sheets, FAQs, social media content, etc.)
- Ensure all materials meet accessibility and language needs

C. Community Engagement

- Advise on or facilitate community listening sessions, town halls, and informational meetings
- Assist with stakeholder presentations (staff, parents, community groups, etc.)
- Develop targeted communications plans

D. Media Relations

- Provide guidance and support on press releases and local media engagement
- Act as spokesperson or assist district staff in media training

E. Digital Communication

- Develop or support referendum-related content on the district's website
- Provide video production and editing services
- Support email and social media campaigns, ensuring accurate information is shared across all platforms

F. Evaluation

- Offer metrics and tools for evaluating the effectiveness of the communication strategy
- Provide post-election analysis and recommendations for future initiatives

4. Proposal Requirements

Proposals should include needed details on the three (3) possible referenda scenarios. Proposals should include the following:

1. Cover Letter: Brief introduction and intent to provide services

2. Firm Qualifications: Background, size, areas of expertise, and relevant experience with school referendums

3. Project Team: Names, roles, and resumes of personnel assigned to the project

4. Approach and Methodology: A detailed plan to accomplish the tasks in the scope of services

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- 5. Project Timeline: Estimated timeline from kickoff to post-election analysis
- 6. References: At least three (3) references from similar engagements

7. Cost Proposal: Breakdown of fees, including hourly rates, project phases, and any reimbursable expenses

5. Evaluation Criteria

Proposals will be evaluated based on:

- Relevant experience with school district referenda (especially in Wisconsin)
- Proposed methodology and approach
- Quality and clarity of the communications plan
- Cost-effectiveness and value
- References and past performance
