Mckinney-Vento

Part of the Every Student Succeeds Act, this law protects eligible students from discrimination and mandates equal access to educational services. Students who are identified as McKinney-Vento eligible must have no barriers to their education.

MCKINNEY-VENTO STUDENTS HAVE THE RIGHTS TO:

Immediate School Enrollment

Even if they lack proof of residency, guardianship, immunizations, or school records.

Transportation

While students are in unstable housing, transportation is provided for students residing outside of attendance area.

School Fee Waivers

Students have the right to equal access of education.

School Choice

Students may choose to stay at the school attended when permanently housed or to enroll in the school where they are currently living for the remainder of the academic year.

Dispute/Appeal: Parents/Guardians/UHY have the right to dispute/appeal decisions made by the district regarding eligibility, school selection, or enrollment.

A STUDENT MAY QUALIFY IF HE OR SHE IS CURRENTLY

- Living in a shelter
- Living in a motel, hotel, or campground due to lack of adequate housing
- Sharing housing with relatives of others due to lack of housing
- Living at a train or bus station, a park, or in a car
- Living in an abandoned building
- A youth not living with a parent or guardian
- A child of a migrant worker
- In other situations that are not fixed, regular, or adequate for night time residence
