Program Focus

Robinson Elementary cares for approximately 430 4yr old through 3rd grade students in a focused academic environment. Students have an opportunity to enroll in bilingual education at the age of 4 and progress through third grade into the intermediate schools with an excellent foundation in the Spanish language. Robinson has a strong PBIS (Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports) program that allows students to learn in a positive environment and be recognized for their outstanding behavior. Student academic achievement is of the highest priority and Robinson continues to enjoy and celebrate our dedicated teachers and their students' academic success with high support from our learning community.

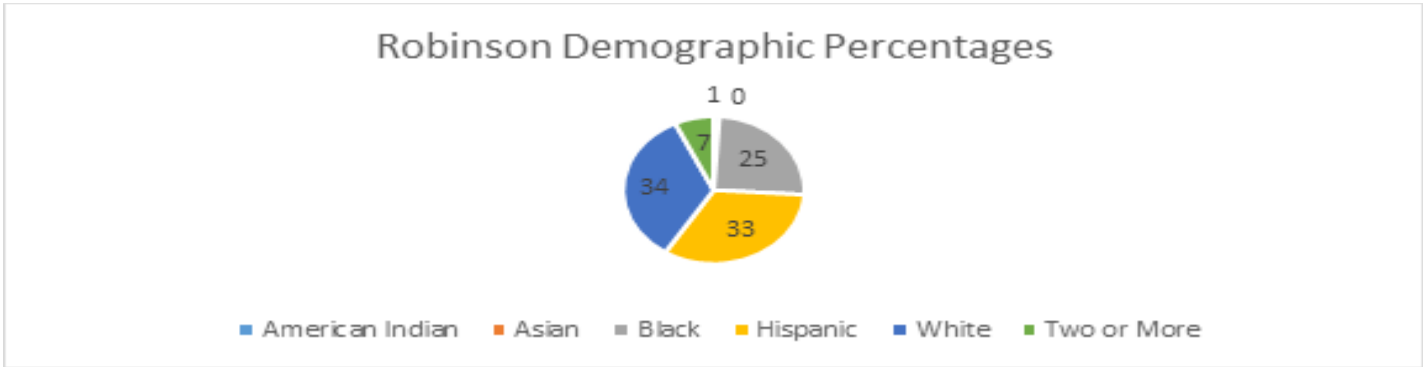

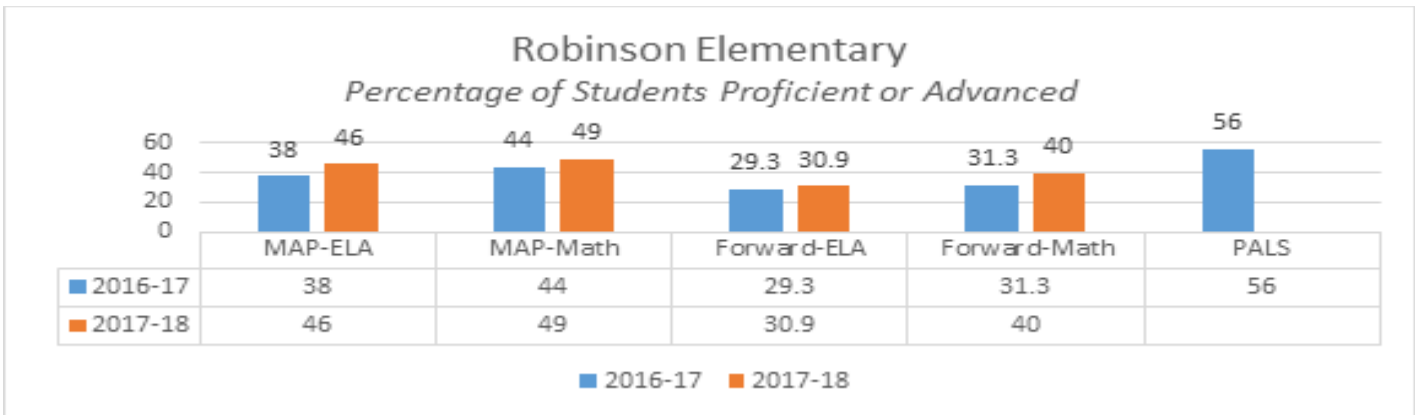

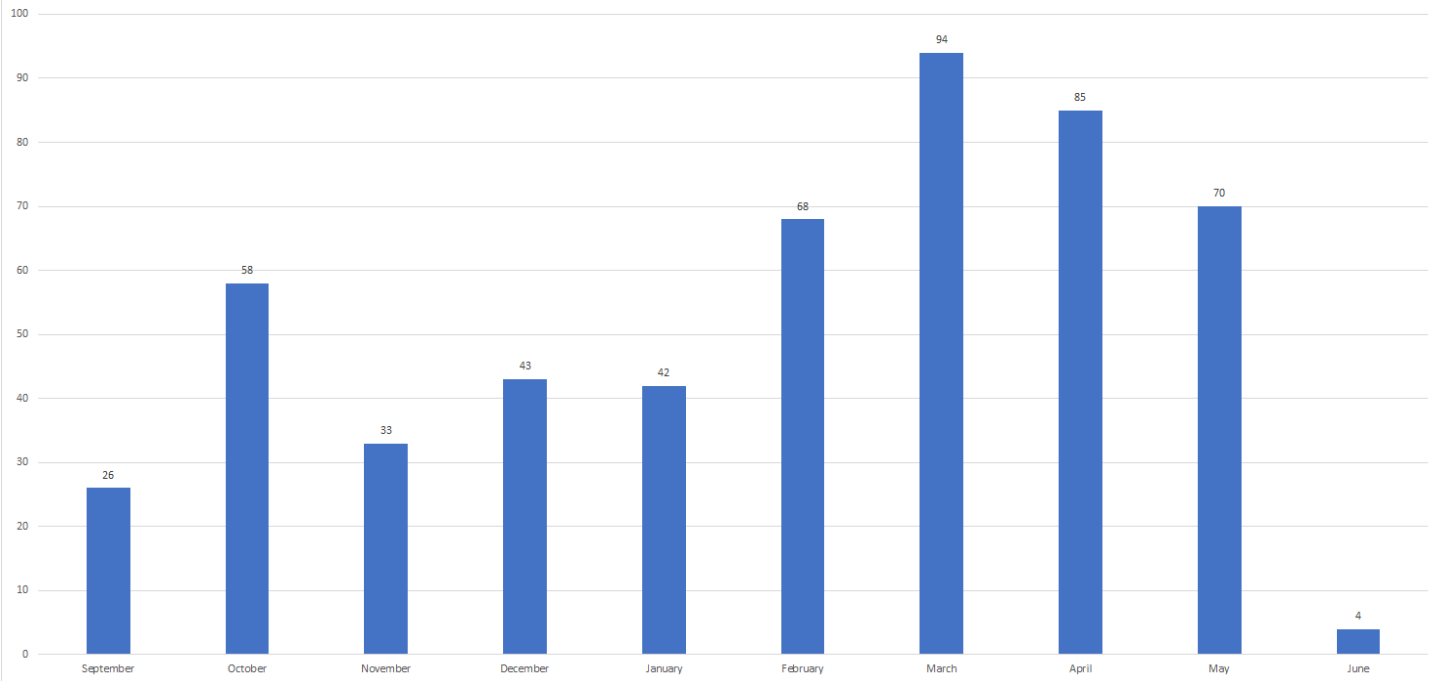
1. The number of students scoring proficient or advance in literacy will increase between 5 – 7% as measured by the Wisconsin Forward Exam each year.
2. All students will increase in math between 3-5% each year as measured by the Wisconsin Forward Exam.



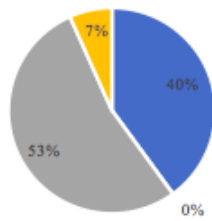

2017-18 Robinson EOY Referrals by Month

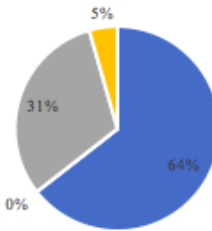
