## Early Childhood Screenings for Special Education

- Do you have a child between the ages 2 5 years?
- Do you have concerns about his/her development?
- Do you suspect delays in speech/language, thinking or motor skills?

## **Typical milestones:**

24-36 months	Child should be able to climb well, turn book pages one at a time, and recognize and identify almost all common objects and pictures
3-4 years	Child should be able to kick and throw a ball, use scissors, draw circles and squares, speak in 5-6 word sentences, tell stories and correctly name some colors.
4-5 years	Child should be able to swing and climb, print some letters, dress independently, recall parts of a story, count to 10 or more objects, wants to please and be with friends, likes to sing, dance and act.
